Merlot (15%)

Climate: Mediterranean climate with dry warm summers

during the day and cooler nights

Vineyard: North Beqaa (east facing slopes of 1,280 - 1,620m

altitude) & Zahle (east facing slopes with 900 - 1000m

altitude)

Soil: Limestone & gravel

Harvest date: 28 August & 04,17 September 2015

Harvest: Handpicked

Skin maceration: 15 days

Oak type & maturation: French oak barrels for 18 months

Notes: A well-structured wine with soft, well integrated tannins and a long finish. The earthiness of beetroot acts as the perfect foil to the lusciousness of black cherries... smoky cedar, blackcurrant, mint, vanilla... A very sensual drop.
