The vertical expression of latitude 33.

Single variety grapes, grown in respect of a specific vineyard site and picked only at full maturity.

Piedmont Barouk, east slopes at 950m altitude in Kefraya village. This medium plus to full bodied wine has medium to deep purple color, followed by aromas of dark cherries, leather, lavender and hint of smoke.

Whole bunch fermentation by indigenous yeast – No filtration & a long maceration period of 3-5 weeks – Aging for 2 years in stainless steel and cement – No additives just a little amount of sulfites.

Produce and bottled by RWC, Bekaa valley.
