Pinot Noir selected from more than 15 years old Château St Thomas vineyards located on 1200m altitude. Yield: 35hl/ha.

Type: Dry Red Wine

Entire harvest cluster, temperature control during fermentation, trapping and pumping, pneumatic pressing, light filtration.

- Berries, strawberries, fresh tobacco, sweet spices.
